Bur Oak	SND to CL	FI to Par	16 X 16	30 - 50	Slow	Large, long lived shade tree. Produces acorns for wildlife forage. Yellow Fall foliage.
Red Maple	SND to CL	FI to Par	16 X 16	50 - 70	Med	Bright red fall foliage. Great as a shade tree and to tap for maple syrup.
Yellow Birch	SND to LM	FI to Par	16 X 16	60 - 100	Med	Large-long lived birch with copper bark. Good for slopes/banks.
Silver Maple	SND to LM	FI to Par	16 X 16	60-90	Fast	Great shade tree and to tap for maple syrup. Good for low areas.
Swamp White Oak	SND to CL	FI to Par	16 X 16	100	Fast	Large, long lived shade tree. Produces acorns for wildlife forage. Tolerant of saturated growing conditions.
American Hazelnut	CL to LM	FI to Par	6 X 6	10	Med	Great hedge shrub. Tasty nut producing and nice yellow Fall color.
American Plum	SND-LM to SND-CL	FI	10 X 10	12 - 20	Fast	Native wild plum. Tasty jams!
Nannyberry	CL to LM	FI to Shd	10 X 10	28	Slow	Pretty flowers and great native ornamental. Clusters of sweet edible berries
Red Splendor Crabapple	SND to CL	FI	10 x 10	20 - 25	Fast	Great for wildlife! Bright pink flowers.
Redosier Dogwood	SND-CL	FI	8 x 8	6 - 12	Fast	Fruit and twigs used by robins, cedar waxwings, rabbits, and deer. Twigs are red, providing winter color and dense wildlife cover.
Serviceberry (Juneberry)	SND-LM to CL	FI to Par	10 x 10	15 - 26	Med	Beautiful White Early Spring Flowering. Edible Fruit.
Wildlife Packet - 4 Season	SND to CL	FI to Par	10 x 10	6 - 28	Med to Fast	Excellent year round wildlife food source. Consider planting in small groups with conifers.

Northern White Cedar	SI to CI	FI to Par	8 X 8	30 - 60	Med	Aromatic evergreen, great winter protection for wildlife.
Norway (Red) Pine	SND to SND-CL	FI to Par	8 X 8	75 - 100	Fast	The Minnesota State Tree.
Tamarack	S to L	FI to Par	8 X 8	80 - 100	Fast	Smokey Gold Fall Foliage. Great deciduous conifer for many soils and light to moderate saturation.
White Pine	LM-SND to CL	FI to Par	8 X 8	75 - 100	Med	Classic beauty...just watch for insects or disease.
White Spruce	LM to CL	FI to Shd	8 X 8	50 - 75	Med	Long lived forest tree. Good in a variety of sites and conditions.
